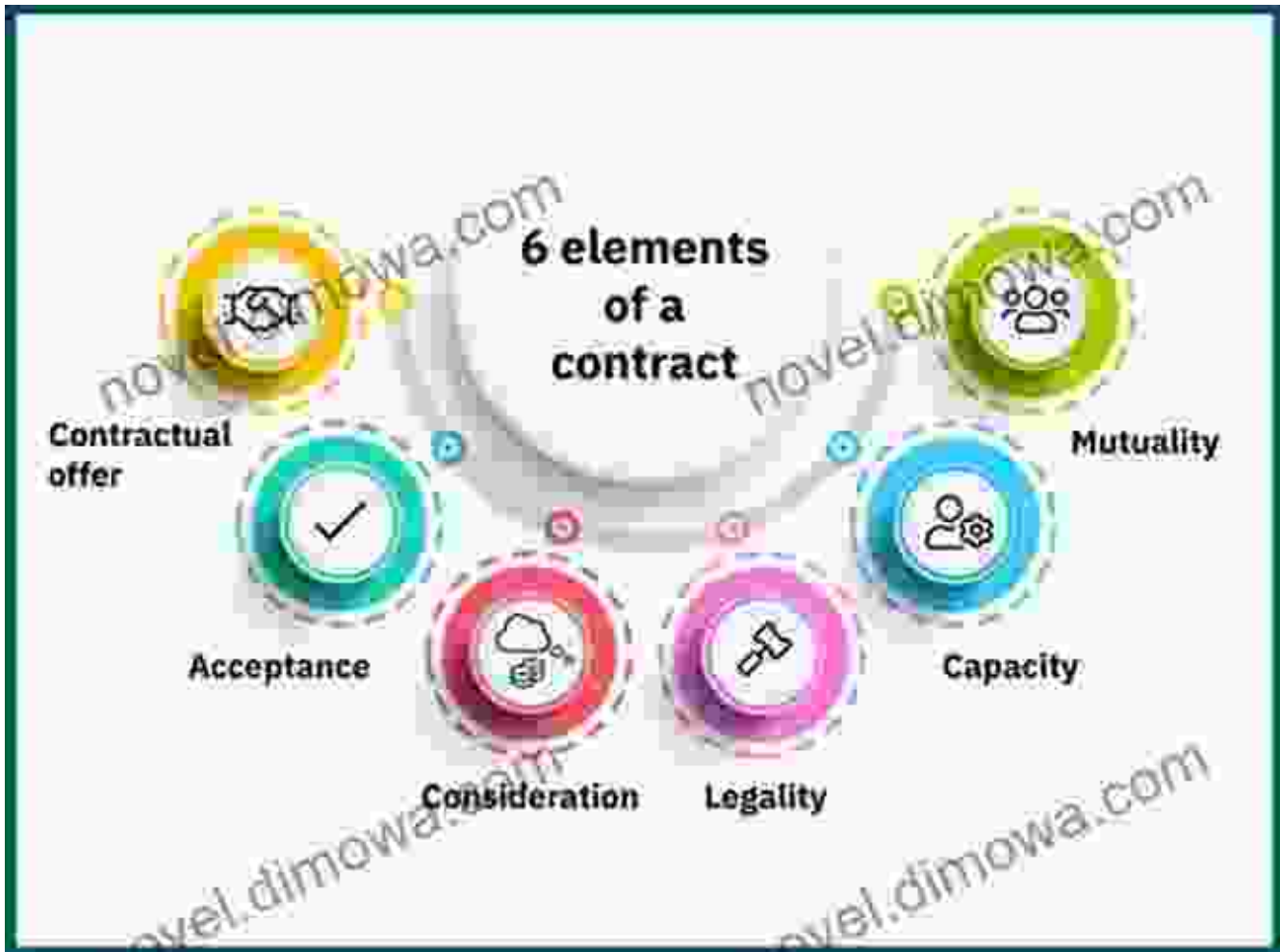

# Interpreter Contract

This Contract is between Smart Minded (the "Client") and John LLC, a Connecticut limited liability company (the "Contractor").

The Contract is dated the date both parties sign:

## 1. WORK AND PAYMENT.

**1.1 Project.** The Client is hiring the Contractor to do the following: the Contractor will assist the Client in a variety of tasks.

**1.2 Schedule.** The Contractor will begin work on July 21, 2022 and will continue until the work is completed. This Contract can be ended by either Client or Contractor at any time, pursuant to the terms of Section 6, Term and Termination.

**1.3 Payment.** The Client will pay the Contractor a flat fee of \$5,000.00 (USD). Of this, the Client will pay the Contractor \$1,000.00 (USD) before work begins.

**1.4 Expenses.** The Client will reimburse the Contractor's expenses. Expenses do not need to be pre-approved by the Client.

**1.5 Invoices.** The Contractor will invoice the Client at the end of the project. The Client agrees to pay the amount owed within 15 days of receiving the invoice. Payment after that date will incur a late fee of 1.0% per month on the outstanding amount.

**1.6 Support.** The Contractor will offer service support for any deliverable once the Client accepts it, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

## 2. OWNERSHIP AND LICENSES.

**2.1 Client Owns All Work Product.** As part of this job, the Contractor is creating "work product" for the Client. To avoid confusion, work product is the finished product, as well as drafts, notes, materials, mockups, hardware, designs, inventories, patents, code, and anything else that the Contractor works on—that is, conceives, creates, designs, develops, invents, works on, or reduces to practice—in just of this project, whether before the date of this Contract or after. The Contractor hereby gives the Client this work product once the Client pays for it in full. This means the Contractor is giving the Client all of its rights, titles, and interests in and to the work product (including intellectual property rights), and the Client will be the sole owner of it. The Client can use the work product however it wants or team decide not to use the work product at all. The Client, for example, can modify, destroy, or sell it, as it sees fit.

**2.2 Contractor's Use Of Work Product.** Once the Contractor gives the work product to the Client, the Contractor does not have any rights to it, except those that the Client explicitly gives the Contractor here. The Client gives permission to use the work product as part of websites and software, in patents, and in other media, as long as it is to promote the work product for any other purpose. The Client does not give permission to sell or otherwise use the work product in trademarks or for any other commercial use. The Client is not allowed to take back that license, even after the Contractor dies.

**2.3 Contractor's Help Securing Ownership.** In the future, the Client may need the Contractor's help to prove that the Client owns the work product or to complete the transfer. The Contractor agrees to help with that. For example, the Contractor may help sign a patent application. The Client will pay any required expenses for this. If the Client can't find the Contractor, the Contractor agrees that the Client can ask the Contractor's lawyer to accomplish the same thing. The Client agrees to pay the Client's cost of the Contractor's lawyer. The Contractor's lawyer is responsible for

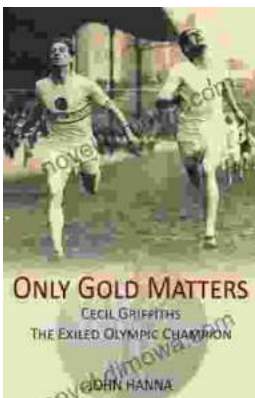
